While at the same time it makes a school life full of enjoyable experiences with this vision various activities have been organized whole year in pre-primary wing to encourage children for expressing themselves and to Foster their creativity in the form of Rainbow Activity, Puzzle Learning Activity ,Best Out of Waste Activity, Balloon Activity, Kite Decoration, Rubber and Bulb Activity, through these activities enhance their learning by pragmatic approach. Apart from this various activities are conducted to raise their academic excellence such as Recitation competition, Calligraphy Competitions to hone their writing and speaking skills. b) **Activities conducted in Junior, Middle and Senior Wing**- To promote the competitive spirit and to bring out the talent of the students they were encouraged to participate in various co-curricular activities conducted during the whole course of the Year like calligraphy, parliamentary Quiz Contest, folk dance and song competition, rock show recitation, elocution Diya making, best out of waste product activity, kitchen activity, etc.

Adventure Camp-
